Dear Parent/Guardian,

1. A district which provides transportation for resident public school students must also make identical provisions for the transportation of resident nonpublic school students.
2. Transportation for nonpublic school students must be provided to and from the nonpublic school in which the student is enrolled, even if the nonpublic school is located outside the district so long as the distance is not more than 10 miles beyond the district boundaries. (NOTE: This distance may be in excess of 10 miles from student's home.)
3. A district may transport children who live along hazardous routes even though the children live within walking distance of the school.

Elementary: 1.5 miles to school Secondary: 2.0 miles to school (except hazardous routes declared by PennDOT)
2. We cannot bus to a daycare or babysitter or any stop other than the closest stop to your house past fourth grade. If this is necessary, it is the parent's responsibility to make arrangements with the babysitter, daycare or non-public school for transportation.
3. Child cannot have two bus tickets. Child must have one pick up and one drop off point everyday.
4. You MUST be a resident of Pottsville. If you are not, you must request transportation from the district in which you are a resident of REGARDLESS of the pick up and drop off stops requested.
